INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE CHARLES J. "CHUCK" BROWNE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships shall be awarded to the members in good standing of the Federation of Public Employees or the Federation of Private Employees, their spouses, registered domestic partners, children, legal dependents, or grandchildren. **Membership in good standing is defined as being a dues-paying member for a minimum of one year, with dues current.**

Scholarship recipients can only be awarded a scholarship one time. The Federation staff is ineligible to participate in the Scholarship fund. Scholarship recipients will receive the awards payable to their educational institution only and the awards can be used for tuition, books and dorms. A scholarship recipient will not lose the award for non use in the two years if in that period the recipient was in active military duty.

The number of scholarships and the amount will be determined in the near future.

1. Please fill out the application in its entirety.
2. The subject of the 500 word (minimum) essay should be on **"In this new era of technology, what would be the best way for Unions to communicate with their members?"** The essay may include charts, graphs, attachments and media devices such as videos or CD's. **Also include copies of your LATEST TRANSCRIPTS showing your grade point average, documentation on VOLUNTARY ACTIVITIES and a brief written ESSAY ON YOUR LONG-TERM GOALS.**

The winners essay questions may be posted on our upcoming website therefore, please submit a hard copy as well as a diskette or CD of the essay question.

3. The applicant and member must sign the application prior to it being submitted.
4. All applications and transcripts must be postmarked no later than SEPTEMBER 14, 2018.
5. The applications and transcripts should be mailed to the address listed below.

The Scholarship Fund Committee will carefully review all applications and a decision will be made no later than November 13, 2018.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

(High School Students & College Applicants - Page Three)

1. CONDITIONS OF AWARD: All Scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to the educational institution for tuition, fees and expenses. Scholarships must be used within a two-year period of being awarded. Those Scholarships not used within two years, will be forfeited and returned to the Scholarship fund.

2. RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

All eligible applicants must be members in good standing, or have a parent or grandparent who is a member in good standing. **A member in good standing is defined as being a dues paying member for a minimum of one year. Current on their dues.**

All eligible applicants must include with their application the following: A minimum 500 word essay on ***"In this new era of technology, what would be the best way for Unions to communicate with their members?"*** The essay may include charts, graphs, attachments and media devices such as videos or CD's. Make sure to include a bibliography of the sources used in preparation for writing the essay. In addition, copies of applicant's transcripts showing their grade average, documentation on volunteer activities they are involved in with the community. A brief written essay on their long-term career goals must also be included. The winners' essay may be posted on our website. Therefore, please submit a hard copy as well as a CD of the essay response. Applications must be submitted to the Federation office no later than September 14, 2018 at 4:00 PM for consideration.

The Scholarship Fund Committee will carefully review all applications and a decision will be made. Applications must be submitted to the Federation office 1700 NW 66TH AVE. Plantation, FL 33313, no later than September 14, 2018 at 4:00 PM for consideration. The Scholarship Fund Committee will carefully review all applications and a decision will be made.
